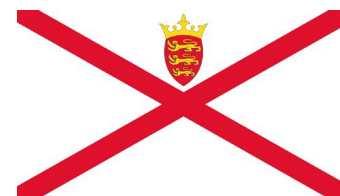

Conditions of Play

1. Team Structure:

- Teams will comprise of 10 men (plus 2 substitutes) and 10 women players (plus 2 substitutes).
- England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales have entered two teams of each gender, with Jersey entering one team of each gender.
- Players are permitted to be interchanged and rotated between disciplines after the completion of each round. All changes must be notified to the 'Organising Committee' at least 15 minutes prior to the round of which the change will occur.

2. Disciplines:

SINGLES: Four bowls, first to 21 shots

PAIRS: Three bowls per player, 18 ends

TRIPLES: Two bowls per player, 18 ends

FOURS: Two bowls per player, 15 ends



3. Competition Format:

There will be two sections.

Each section will consist of one team from England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales. Jersey have been drawn to be drawn into Section 1.

4. Event Structure and Points Allocation:

Each country will play the other teams in their group with each match consisting of the above four individual disciplines.

There will be a total of 10 points available for each match:

- Two points for overall match result – if scores tied then one point each
- Two points for an individual discipline win
- One point for an individual discipline draw (no extra ends will be played in any discipline)

At the conclusion of the Group, placings within each group will be determined as follows.

- Points Won
- Shot Difference
- Least number of shots conceded
- Overall match result between the two tied teams
- Points scored in match between the two tied teams
- Winner of 1st end of the Singles match between the two tied teams

There will be a playoff between the two teams topping their respective groups for Gold and Silver and a playoff between the two Runners-up for Bronze.

5. Time Limits:

A time limit of 2 hours and 15 mins (not including trial ends) will apply to all matches for all disciplines.
