<b>Level 1 Bowls Coaching Award</b>  <b>(L1BCA)</b>	<p><b>Develop and improve existing players within your club.</b></p> <p>Coaches will leave with the knowledge, skills and confidence to deliver fun, safe and progressive sessions to develop club players using skills-based practices to produce a more consistent line and length.</p>	2 days	£60 – affiliated clubs £120 – non affiliated	Coaches should be aged 16 years or above on the date of the course and hold an IBCA or an old club coach award.
<b>Level 2 Bowls Coaching Award</b>  <b>(L2BCA)</b>	<p><b>Coming soon</b></p> <p>This award is currently being developed and it will be aimed at coaches working with talented players who are operating at regional academy level and above.</p>	TBC	TBC	Coaches should be aged 16 years or above on the date of the course and hold an L1BCA.
<b>Bowls Inclusion Workshop *</b>	<p>Led by Scottish Disability Sport, coaches will leave the workshop with a greater understanding of how to coach bowlers with a physical, visual or learning disability.</p>	3 hours	FREE	Coaches should be aged 16 years or above on the date of the course.
