**Please read the following details before completing the entry form:**

### Entry Criteria:

- Entrants must be a member of a Bowls Scotland affiliated club – players **do not** have to be from the same club to enter the competition
- Entrants **must be 25 or under on or before 1st April 2020** to be able to play in the British Isles Junior Pairs Championship

### Dates:

- Entries open on **Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2020**
- Entries close at 4:00pm on **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2020**
- The competition will take place on **Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> May\* 2020** at the National Centre for Bowling, Northfield, Hunters Avenue, Ayr, KA8 9AL
- **The winning pair must be available to play in the BIWBC Junior Pairs Championships to be held at Llandrindod Wells BC, Wales, on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2020. Bowls Scotland will arrange travel & accommodation. The winning pair will travel to the event with the International team on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July and return home on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> July.**

### Format:

- \*1 or 2 day competition – dependent on entries
- 2 Bowl Pairs
- Round robin with entries divided into sections
- The final playing format will be decided once entries have closed, dependent on entries

- Dress code as per Stage 1 of the National Championships
- Medals will be awarded to the winners and runner up
- Catering will be available on the day for players to purchase lunch/snacks/drinks etc
