

Bowls Scotland Club Crisis Fund - Note of Interest Form

The Bowls Scotland Club Crisis Fund launched in May 2020 was setup to provide grants to clubs that find themselves in financial difficulty directly as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The primary intention of the fund is to help clubs to stabilise and manage cash flows over this difficult period. The fund will provide grants up of either £500 or £1000 to cover green maintenance; rent; utilities; and loss of income.

For this second cohort of crisis fund applications, we have moved to a two-step process to ensure clubs in the most need are financially supported. To help us assess if your club meets the criteria for application, please complete the eligibility checker.
