## Affiliation for the 2022 Season

As part of our progression to becoming a more efficient and modern organisation, we introduced a new online membership system for affiliation (Capitation) in 2021. The system is also utilised for other services including coach education and club development workshops. As an interim measure, we also offered an interactive PDF document as a stepping-stone towards online affiliation. We were delighted to see approximately 500 of our 834 clubs and many of our associations and affiliates returned their capitation electronically.

As a result of this success, from 2022 onwards, no return paperwork or interactive PDF will be issued as standard. Affiliation and competition entries will be open from Wednesday 12th January via Bowls Scotland's online club and membership system which can be accessed by clicking on this link: <u>https://bowlsscotland.justgo.com/Account.mvc/Signln</u>

We understand that this might be daunting, but please be assured that we will provide all the necessary support to ensure the process is as seamless and straightforward as possible. To support affiliation through the online club and membership system, we have put in place a training programme.

To affiliate via the online system, clubs, associations, and affiliates will need to:

- Identify someone who will act as the system administrator. The system administrator will be responsible for purchasing affiliation via the system and viewing / updating club and member information (main contacts, coaches, wellbeing protection officer etc.)
- Pay via bank transfer or card via the system OR request an invoice and pay by cheque or BACS in the normal way.
- If paying by cheque, please make payable to Bowls Scotland. Please pay using one cheque and print a copy of your invoice from the online club and membership system and send to Bowls Scotland, National Centre for Bowling, Hunters Avenue, Ayr, KA8 9AL
