TRAVEL INFORMATION

Park & Ride

There is a Park & Ride in operation for the duration of the event which is free to use. It is located at Afton Avenue (KA8 9EG – Directly at the end of Hunters Avenue). Coaches run every 10 minutes to the National Centre.

By Bus

Stagecoach Busses operate a circular service (Number 2 & 6) between Ayr Town Centre and Asda which passes the National Centre for Bowling. Multiple bus stops are located on Hunters Avenue, the closest being approximately 200 meters from the Main Entrance at the Retail Marquee. These busses operate every 20minutes.

You will also be able to use the 4 & 14 Bus Service as well; they stop all along Prestwick Road and run approximately every 15/20min depending on the time of day. The closest Prestwick Road bus stop is approximately a 5-minute walk to the National Centre for Bowling.

By Train (Newton-on-Ayr stop)

Newton-on-Ayr train station is approximately an 8 minute walk from the National Centre for Bowling. The train station is serviced approximately every 25/35min depending on the time of day, with more frequent trains at peak times. *Please note that not every train stops at Newton-on-Ayr*

By Taxi / private hire bus

The two most prominent local Taxi Companies are;

The easiest option is to arrange for collection & drop-off is at Bellesleyhill Avenue between Alderston Avenue and Bellesleyhill Road due to the busses operating to and from the Main Entrance. The 3 words for this location is "Tiny. Sticks. Cloth".
