First Aid Courses

In 2021, we surveyed clubs to assess what provision was required to support clubs with First Aid training and access to Defibrillators. On the back of this survey, we are working in partnership with Henry's First Aid Qualifications to provide First Aid courses. These courses are tailored to the needs of Bowling Clubs and include training on all types of Defibrillators and other emergency first aid topics.
