Role Status:	Voluntary (Training, Kit, IT Equipment and Expenses Paid)
Reports To:	Bowls Scotland National Development Officers

Purpose:	To support Bowls Scotland affiliated clubs with the planning, delivery, and evaluation of Bowls Scotland's Try Bowls Programme.
Time Commitment:	2 Bowls Scotland Development Sessions (full days) pre & post season
	5-month delivery April – August (Support a minimum of 5 Try Bowls clubs)

Key Responsibilities:

- In partnership with clubs, plan, deliver and evaluate Try Bowls events at a local level
- Engage the local community to participate in bowling
- Encourage clubs to take positive steps to identify and overcome barriers to participation
- Collate and provide participation data to Bowls Scotland's National Development Officers
- Promote Try Bowls events on social media and work with Bowls Scotland Marketing and Communication team to promote Try Bowls events including taking photographs and quotes
- Manage personal expenses associated with travel and subsistence required for the role within agreed budgets adhering to the expenses policy, submitting returns monthly.
- Uphold the organisation values of Bowls Scotland
- Maintain knowledge and adhere to the published Bowls Scotland policies relevant to the role
