INTRODUCTION TO COACHING PARA BOWLS AWARD

The Introduction to Coaching Para Bowls award is our newest Coaching Qualification and is aimed at allowing coaches to experience and understand coaching bowlers with a disability. Para Bowls is the fast-growing area of Bowls in Scotland and with fantastic results on the world stage in recent years, we hope to encourage more clubs to encourage Para Bowlers to develop their skills as much as possible.

The course will provide an introduction to Visually Impaired Bowls as well as Physically Disabled bowlers. Coaches will get the opportunity to try out some specific Para Bowls equipment, as well as gather hints and tips to make their coaching sessions more inclusive and open to all players with a disability. This course has been designed in partnership with Scottish Disability Sport and will provide coaches with the confidence and knowledge to ensure their club is as inclusive as possible.

Structure: 2 Hours online pre-course learning & 3 Hours on-green training (5 Hours)

MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS FOR COACHES

This 90-minute session will be delivered by professionals from SAMH and will allow you to explore skills and resources to build confidence in having a mental health conversation with one of your players as their coach.

The session will explore what having a mental health conversation might look like between a coach and a player and the steps to take when having/considering a mental health conversation.

The main aims of the session are

- Identify and understand ways to help you have a Mental Health Conversation with your players
- Build knowledge of a potential structure for having a mental health
- Develop an understanding of role and responsibilities of the coach and how to manage expectations.
- Explore support for yourself and other coaches, including effective self-care building and external support services available.
