Reports to: Competition and Events Officer (Bowls Scotland)

Term: Reviewed annually (no maximum term)

Time Commitment: Meeting frequency will initially be front loaded with two contact points per month in Aug/Sept/Oct/Nov, and then quarterly thereafter. Ad hoc meetings with a specific purpose will be communicated when and if necessary.
