As a working group member, you will be expected to canvas views and opinions on behalf of the group and feedback into discussions, development and implementations.

Bowls Scotland has a set of values, outlined within our Corporate Strategy and available on our website. We are committed to selecting working group members based on their experience and ability to do the role for which they are being recruited.

Notes of interest are now invited from candidates with lived experience from a variety of backgrounds and with knowledge or experience of equality in a sporting context. We would particularly welcome applications from people under the age of 25, females and people with a disability, as underrepresented groups in the bowling workforce.
