Job Purpose:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Provide assistance to the Pathway Performance Team in the selection of the Bowls Scotland's international squads and teams.• Provide data, advice and insight on the performance and development of bowlers identified on the performance pathway.

Remuneration:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This is a voluntary role• Reimbursement for all reasonable expenses properly incurred in the performance of your duties in accordance with Bowls Scotland financial procedures.
Time commitment:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Workflow will be based on needs of the programme but includes; attendance at regional and national events, assessment days, pathway days and selection meetings.• Attendance at development or international events when required to support the team.• This is not expected to exceed the equivalent of 15 days per year.
Operational Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To work with the Pathway Performance Team to ensure they have the best possible up to date information and data regarding the performance of talented young players, prospective international players and current international players.• To collect detailed scoring information on prospective international players aligned with the What It Takes To Win Scoring model.• To develop a network of reliable contacts to build a sound knowledge of players.• To attend and provide player assessment at regional events and National events including but not restricted to: Podium Opens, Pathway days, Assessment days, National Championships.• To attend meetings as required by the Pathway Performance Team to provide data-led player analysis to support the team's selection for Bowls Scotland's performance programme and national team events.• To adhere to the Bowls Scotland Selection Policy.
